Attached is a zoning analysis conducted by our attorneys, it clearly shows that the proposed cell tower at Sampson Ave fails to meet any standard of Bylaws. Nor any standard of good judgement, of sound reasoning, of basic human decency.

- Alternative sites have never been properly considered.

There are better, safer, more complaint, less impactful sites on Chappaquiddick to site a cell tower that does not deprive any one of service, and in fact provides better service to more people, providing a greater safety benefit to more people. Sites that preserve property values for everyone on Chappy, preserve individuals' right to the safety and quiet enjoyment of their homes, that moves the tower off the public right of way, out into the woods where it more equally shares the burden of a cell tower on Chappaquiddick among all the residents and which reduces the stigmatization, and social stratification of Chappaquiddick and Edgartown.

Locations where your grandchildren, and their children will not curse your for cow-towing to corporations and billionaires, for surrendering your reputation to some politician as she slides out the door, for standing up for what is right, and honorable, brave and courageous. For standing with those who have already stood firm in the face of lies and subterfuge, of dishonesty and disingenuousness. This is your one opportunity to atone for your sins, and to stand up for what is right, to act honorably, to preserve your dignity, and your reputation.
