

Selectmen's Meeting
May 7, 2012
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the Fred B. Morgan Jr. Meeting Room, Town Hall. Members present were: Michael J. Donaroma, Chairman; Margaret Serpa; and Arthur Smadbeck.

At 4:00 pm Mr. Donaroma opened the meeting. The Board then approved the following items:

The minutes of April 30, 2012.

A Common Victualler License for Skinny's Fat Sandwiches.

Mr. Donaroma then opened the scheduled Nstar hearing for permission to install about 30' of cable and conduit under South Water St. to #6 S. Water Street. Present from Nstar was Karen Corriveau, Right of Way Agent. Representing the owners of the property was Gino Courtney. Stuart Fuller, Highway Superintendent was also present.

Mr. Fuller reminded the Board that the project had to be done before May 15th which is the cutoff date for street work down town for the summer. There would be no disruption of the road because they were going to bore under it. If any damage were to occur he asked that it be restored.

Ms. Serpa moved to approve the application with the deadline to finish before May 15th and to restore any damage to the road or sidewalk, if any. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. Unanimous.

Mr. Donaroma asked if there was any further business. Ms. Rose stated that the Police Chief wanted to let everyone know that the Prom was on Saturday and that some parking spaces would be blocked off at the Yacht Club and the Harbor View.

The Board extended all expiring appointments to Committees and Boards to May 14, 2012.

Ms. Serpa moved to adjourn at 4:04 PM. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. Unanimous.
