 - The winter storms had changed the shoreline including a field of huge boulders off Wasque, and sand coming down through Duarte, and the erosion resulting in the Schifter house move.
 - Staff reported some adult and seed scallops in Pocha Pond.
 - Summer and year round staff were working well and the Sengekontacket Oyster Project was proceeding on schedule (see documents on file).
 - The quahog relay and family culling was a success. Staff encouraged fishing at the Katama area.
