Proposed Water Transmission Main:

Mill Hill Tank Update:

- The contractors are supposed to be on Island the first or second week of October. Mr. Chapman has not heard exactly when they will be here.
- USDA wants the loan to be closed out as soon as possible.
- The finial does not look like there is a screen in it. The bladder system is in there. The contractor should verify that.

Oak Bluffs Interconnection:

Oak Bluffs has drained their tank and the interconnection is open. There were some issues with the Scada system losing communication with our tank. The problem was from another tower that belongs to a bus company. The bus company is not using that tower until the problem can be resolved.

Lead & Copper Testing:

30 samples had been collected. The highest levels are well under the action level. The corrosion control is working.

NEW BUSINESS:

September Operational Report:

- Routine mowing completed
- Residents initiated the process to have a hydrant installed at the end of Hamblen Way.
- Lead & Copper sample results were received with favorable results.
- The damage at Quenomica from the faulty air release valve has been repaired by the water Department.
- Final paving was completed at several sites.
- The Water Department did a water main extension on 18th St South.

Other Business:

- Waiting on prices for replacement doors at Wintucket.
- ATM articles were discussed
- The contract for Nunnepog Well rehab has been reviewed by the procurement officer. 95% completed.
