DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

Owners/Applicants: Peter & Susan Eident

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At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 13 May 2020, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (0-5) to grant a special permit under section 10.1 G of the zoning bylaw to allow the installation of a swimming pool on property located at 26 Woodhaven Drive (Assr. Pcl. 10-1.116) as shown on the plan dated 19 March 2013.

- 1. The board finds that proposal conforms to the necessary setbacks. The only nonconformity is the size of the lot, which is in a neighborhood of similarly sized one-acre lots. (A conforming lot in the R-60 neighborhood is one and a half acres.)
- 2. The board finds that the proposal is compatible with the neighborhood as there are several pools in the vicinity and no abutters spoke against the project.
- 3. The applicant is proposing a 6-foot high stockade fence around the pool. The pool equipment will be installed in a fenced enclosure next to the house and the existing air conditioning equipment. Should neighbors complain about noise from the pool equipment, the applicant agrees to fully enclose and sound-proof the enclosure.
