DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 26 August 2020, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (5-0) to grant a special permit under section 10.1 G of the zoning bylaw to allow the construction of an addition and the installation of a swimming pool on a preexisting nonconforming lot located at 21 Metells Way (Assr. Pcl. 36-211) as shown on to the site plan dated 4 August 2020 by Sourati Engineering Group and on the elevations dated 6 July 2020 by Sherman Associates.

FINDINGS:

1. The board finds that proposed pool and the addition conform to the required setbacks.

2. The board finds the proposal to be compatible with the neighborhood as there were no issues or concerns raised by abutters or members of the public. An immediate abutter wrote in full support of the project.

3. There was no opposition to the project from town boards or departments.

CONDITIONS:

No additional conditions were proposed.
