**DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS
ON THE APPLICATION OF
KELLI & ADAM KLAUBER
And
Randall W. Antik**

At a meeting held in the Selectmen's Room, Town Hall, on Wednesday, 20 May 2015, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted (5-0) to approve a request for a special permit under section 11.9 (f) of the bylaw to allow the construction of an addition and the installation of a swimming pool on a nonconforming lot located at 20 Mullen Way, Assr. Pcl. 29A Lot 46 in the R-20 Residential District. The following condition was placed on the permit:

Pool equipment is to be fully enclosed to mitigate mechanical noise. Building permit for the pool may not be issued until the location of the pool equipment has been finalized and approved by the board.

This decision of the Board of Appeals and a record of all proceedings are on file in the zoning board office and in the office of the Town Clerk, Town Hall under Case No: 19-2015.
