

Selectmen's Meeting
August 9, 2010
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the Fred B Morgan Jr. Meeting Room, Town Hall. Members present were Margaret E. Serpa, Chairman; Arthur Smadbeck; and Michael J. Donaroma. Also present was Ms. Pamela Dolby, Town Administrator.

At 4:00 p.m Ms. Serpa opened a posted Nstar hearing to install conduit and cable in front of 7 Fuller St. Ms. Karen Coriveau, Nstar representative, was present. Ms. Serpa read the public notice and asked for any comment.

Mr. Stuart Fuller, Highway Superintendent, stated he would like to see the drill process used under the road.

Ms Serpa asked for any more comment. There being none, she closed the hearing.

Mr. Smadbeck moved to approve the request from NStar with the stipulation that they use the drilling process mentioned by the Highway Superintendent. Mr. Donaroma seconded. Unanimous.

The Board then approved the following items:

A Yard Sale permit for Emily Northridge at 54 Saddleclub Rd. on 8/14 and 8/15 from 9am – 4pm.

A travel voucher for the Wastewater Department.

A Commercial Marine License renewal for Daniel Gilkes for Clean Sweep Charters.

At 4:05 pm Ms. Serpa opened a posted Nstar hearing to install conduit and cable in front of 200 Katama Rd.

Mr. Fuller again requested drilling under the road as the method of installing the conduit because the road surface was almost new.

There being no further comment, Ms. Serpa closed the hearing.

Mr. Smadbeck moved to approve the request with the stipulation of horizontal drilling. Mr. Donaroma seconded. Unanimous.

Ms. Dolby reminded the Board that there was a hearing at the Water Department on Tuesday for the Police Department to put an antennae on the Water Tower.

The Board appointed Joe Alosso to the Joint Sengekontacket Task Force.

Ms. Serpa then recused herself.

Ms. Wanda Williams then swore in Mr. Tony Bettencourt as the new Police Chief. Mr. Bettencourt's wife and friends were in attendance to witness and there was a small round of applause to follow.

Mr. Donaroma reminded the new Chief Bettencourt that that would be the easiest thing he would get to do as Chief.

Mr. Donaroma moved to adjourn at 4:10pm. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. Unanimous.
