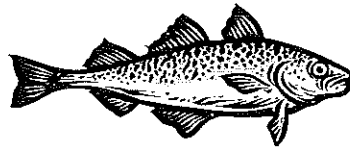


# **Saltwater Fishing License Information**

15 to fish for finfish in MA.**

**If you have a Saltwater License from NH, RI, or CT  
the state of MA will recognize your license here!**

**They are \$10 for ages 16-59 years old.**

**They are FREE to those lucky people 60 or over!**
