All smoke alarms are required to be photoelectric and must be the same brand. Cathedral ceilings require detection between 4 and 12 inches from the peak. (Performance option: V ceilings are high and future serviceability is of concern, these devices can be placed on the vertical s adjacent wall as long as it is more than 4 and less than 12 inches from peak). Smoke alarm shall be a minimum of 36" horizontally from HVAC supply vent, ceiling Fan blade tip, or bathroom door with a shower or tub. 	() () When
 On every level of the residence and located within 10 feet of each bedroom door. One in every room above or adjacent to a garage Combination alarms (photoelectric smoke and carbon monoxide alarm) with distinguishable voice may be used. Must be hardwired and interconnected with battery backup (may be separately wired from the existing smoke detection system). If there is a finished portion in the basement or attic, then the alarm must be in that portion. Heat Detectors are required as follows: In any attached garage or integral garage (garage under) a heat detector listed for the ambient temperature shall be installed. 	()()()()
