

INVITATION FOR BIDS
TOWN OF EGARTOWN
SURPLUS BEACH SAND

The Dredge Department of the Town of Edgartown will receive sealed bids for the purchase of Dredge Spoils from the Edgartown Great Pond site to be used solely as Beach Nourishment or Dune Restoration. Successful bidders shall hold all valid Local, State and Federal permits for both dredging and disposal of said spoils; in conjunction with the Town of Edgartown. The estimated volumes are in excess of 15,000 cu. yds. and the successful bidder must commit to take at least 5,000 cu. yds. The spoils will be deposited on the dewatering site on South Beach as permitted by the Town. Additionally, the successful bidders shall be responsible for all necessary on site dewatering, material handling, transport and final grading at dewatering site and final destination. The minimum bid for said spoils is set at \$20.00 per cu. yd. for contracted volumes up to 5,000 cu. yds.; \$17.50 per cu. yd. for contracted volumes from 5,000 cu. yds. – 10,000 cu. yds. and \$15.00 cu. yd. for contracted volumes in excess of 10,000 cu. yds. out of the pipe. Bids are due November 8, 2013 at noon.
