The Edgartown Police Department is seeking competitive sealed bids for the replacement of six (6) exterior and one (1) interior door at the Edgartown Police Station. The new doors will be equipped with an electronic security system and all associated new security components and power requirements will be included in the contract price. The Contractor will be responsible for providing all labor and materials necessary to do the work.

Bids must be submitted, *sealed* and in writing, to the Town of Edgartown Procurement Office, Edgartown Town Hall, Third Floor, 70 Main Street (or mailed to P.O. Box 5158), Edgartown Massachusetts 02539, in a package plainly marked "*Bid for Police Station Door Renovations, REF EPD-17-5*" on or before 12:00PM, Monday, July 25, 2016. Bids will be publicly opened at that time by the Chief Procurement Officer and a witness. Award will be made within thirty (30) days after the bid opening. Bidders must submit a five percent (5%) bid deposit with their bid. Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, chapter 149, sections 26 and 27, the Division of Occupational Safety has determined the Prevailing Wage Rates for this work and they are included as part of the bid package. The Town of Edgartown reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in its best interest. The Town of Edgartown fully complies with federal, state, and local laws and directives governing equal opportunity, affirmative action and non-discrimination in all Town activities and actively solicits bids from MBE/WBE businesses.
