INVITATION FOR BIDS:

The Edgartown Katama Airfield Commission is seeking bids to replace the existing deck at the Katama Airfield Restaurant, also known as the Right Fork Diner, located at 12 Mattakesett Way, Edgartown, MA 02539. The work includes: demolition of a small (100SF), enclosed “prep room” that was built out over the deck; removal of all existing deck boards, rails and benches; examination of existing framing and reinforcement of existing framing if needed; installation of new decking, rails, ramps and benches. A mandatory site visit will be held on Tuesday, February 26, 2019 at 11:00am.

Contractor is responsible for providing all labor and materials necessary to complete the work. The work must be completed by April 30, 2019.

Bids must be submitted, sealed and in writing, to the Town of Edgartown’s Procurement Office, Edgartown Town Hall, Third Floor, 70 Main Street (or mailed to P.O. Box 5158), Edgartown Massachusetts 02539, in a package plainly marked “Bid to Replace Deck at Airfield Restaurant, REF AIR-19-10” on or before 11:00am, Thursday, March 7th, 2019. Bids will be publicly opened at that time by the Chief Procurement Officer and a witness. No bids submitted after that time will be accepted. Bids must include all the required materials and information. Award will be made within fifteen (15) days after the bid opening. Bidders must submit a five percent (5%) bid deposit with their bid. Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, chapter 149, sections 26 and 27, the Division of Occupational Safety has determined the Prevailing Wage Rates for this work and they are included as part of the bid package. The Town of Edgartown reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in its best interest. The Town of Edgartown fully complies with federal, state, and local laws and directives governing equal opportunity, affirmative action and non-discrimination in all Town activities and actively solicits bids from MBE/WBE businesses.
