### INVITATION FOR BIDS:

The Edgartown Yacht Club, in conjunction with the Edgartown Harbormaster, and acting through the Chief Procurement Officer, is seeking bids for the repair of the sea wall at the end of Main St., adjacent to the Edgartown Yacht Club, in Downtown Edgartown. The work will include removal of existing material, temporary erosion protection, new steel sheet piles, new concrete base, new granite block stones, backfilling and re-installation of brick walkway, granite edging and grout.

The work must be completed by May 15th, 2019. The Contractor will be responsible for providing all labor and materials necessary to do the work.

The estimated cost of the work is \$225,000. There will be two funding sources for the work: the Town of Edgartown (CPC funds) and the Edgartown Yacht Club.

Bids must be submitted, sealed and in writing, to the Town of Edgartown's Procurement Office, Edgartown Town Hall, Third Floor, 70 Main Street (or mailed to P.O. Box 5158), Edgartown Massachusetts 02539, in a package plainly marked "Bid for Sea Wall Repair – Dock Street, REF EYC-19-9" on or before 11:00am, Thursday, January 17th, 2019. Bids will be publicly opened at that time by the Chief Procurement Officer and a witness. No bids submitted after that time will be accepted. Bids must include all the required materials and information. Award will be made within thirty (30) days after the bid opening. Bidders must submit a five percent (5%) bid deposit with their bid. Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, chapter 149, sections 26 and 27, the Division of Occupational Safety has determined the Prevailing Wage Rates for this work and they are included as part of the bid package. The Town of Edgartown reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in its best interest. The Town of Edgartown fully complies with federal, state, and local laws and directives governing equal opportunity, affirmative action and non-discrimination in all Town activities and actively solicits bids from MBE/WBE businesses.
