The Town of Edgartown (“Town”), acting by and through its Katama Airfield Commission (“Commission”), is seeking sealed bids from qualified bidders to engineer, furnish and deliver all required building materials for a pre-engineered metal airplane hangar, per the plans and specifications provided in this Invitation for Bids. This contract does not include any on-site construction services.

Bids must be delivered in a package plainly marked “*Bid for PRE-ENGINEERED METAL HANGAR, Ref: KAC-20-5*” by 12:00pm, Thursday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to the Town of Edgartown Selectmen’s Office, Town Hall (Third Floor), 70 Main Street, or mailed to the Selectmen’s Office, Attn: Procurement, P.O. Box 5158, Edgartown Massachusetts 02539,. Responses must be sealed and must include all forms listed in Section 1.1 of the IFB.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a certified check or money order in the amount of 5% of the total bid, made payable to the Town of Edgartown.

A single contract will be awarded to the responsive and responsible bidder offering the lowest firm fixed price. The Katama Airfield Commission is the Awarding Authority.

The Town of Edgartown reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to amend this Invitation for Bids, to terminate this Invitation for Bids, and to issue a new Invitation for Bids, when it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town in the Town’s sole discretion.
