DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 20 January 2021, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (5-0) to grant a modification to a special permit issued in 2019 (32-19) to allow the conversion of existing storage space above a two-bay garage to a detached bedroom. The property is located at 31 Old Dunhams Corner Way, Assr. Pcl. 37-157.36 - a preexisting, nonconforming lot in the R-60 Residential District.

FINDINGS:

- 1. The board finds that the proposal conforms to the necessary requirements for a detached bedroom and does not exceed 400 sq. ft. as shown on the revised plan dated 25 January 2021.
- 2. No exterior changes or expansion of the structure are proposed; the only changes will be in the interior of the structure and will include providing a half-bath, utilities, and insulation to the space.
- 3. The board finds the proposal to be compatible with the neighborhood, and the site adequate in area for the proposed use.
- 4. There was no opposition to the project from town boards or departments, or from any abutters. .
- 5. The Board of Health has approved the proposal, provided the applicant decommission a bedroom in the main house. The total number of bedrooms on the property will remain at four.

CONDITIONS:

No cooking facilities are permitted.
