- Otherwise staff was building fine mesh bins for the upweller.

• The Selectmen were having a hearing on the new Cape Pogue regulations (see below: Actions), but the bylaw process had not yet been decided.

• A draft report on the Massachusetts Shellfish Initiative (see MSI.org) covered how to better manage shellfish resources in the Commonwealth through such things as: more Division of Marine Fisheries (DMF) testing, better cooperation with labs, wardens/State cooperation, and better State/Federal reporting. Shellfishing in mooring areas was still being discussed and would bear further monitoring.
