In view of Feedback received the Marine Advisory Committee would like to make the following revised recommendations for Cape Pogue Pond for the summer of 2021:

- 1. Mark entrance channel at the gut with no wake buoys at both ends of the channel
- 2. The Harbormaster and Shellfish Constable will make recommendations on the areas that they recommend no anchoring.
- 3. Station a member of Harbormaster Dept / Police / Shellfish in the pond during weekends and holidays during the summer for educational / enforcement issues.

Edgartown Board of Selectmen:

The Shellfish Department was asked by the Marine Advisory Committee to come up with a plan for a limited Anchorage Area for Cape Pogue to allow for access to the pond while keeping boats from anchoring in productive Scalloping areas. In consultation with the Harbormaster and the Shellfish and Marine Advisory Committees. The following area has been suggested it is just inside the Gut. Please see attached Map.

This anchorage area is primarily over a mud hole (Anaerobic area) between two productive Bay Scalloping areas. It will allow for access to the pond while limiting environmental damage and protect the Eel Grass beds found there.
