Update on Energy Conservation Incentives:

Maher Services will be installing the new drive and motor for Quenomica on February 11, 2021. A/D Instruments will come out after and complete their part.

Letter of Response from Tata & Howard:

NEW BUSINESS:

Vote: Additional Principal Payment:

Mr. Kelleher motioned to make a \$15,000 principal payment for the Mill Hill Standpipe Restoration Project. Mr. Ellis seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Abatement Request – 70 Simpson's Ln:

The commissioners requested proof of repair before they will vote on the abatement request.

Tier II Report:

The Tier II report has been completed and filed with the State and the Fire Department.

Conflict of Interest/Open Meeting Law:

All employees and commissioner are required to take a test yearly on these laws.

Operational Report:

- The S.C.A.D.A. (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) system received one of its annual check-ups with no faults found. To further safeguard the system, additional protection software was installed with the most current safety features.
- The new motor and variable frequency drive have been installed in the Quenomica Pumping Station. The upgrades have been coupled with our S.C.A.D.A. system. The pumping station has been tested and is now ready for the anticipated high demands of the coming summer season. This was the final pumping station to receive this upgrade.
- The main on Tower Hill Road / Green Hollow Way has been pressure tested and sampled for bacteria, with the activation of domestic services expected soon.
- Components within the pumping stations was painted to extend useful service life. All four pumping stations have experienced extensive maintenance throughout the winter season. All facilities are at the ready for the high demands of the summer pumping station.
- Energy conservation measures in progress include the replacement of the heating units at the Water Department garage, low flow aerators on the faucets and a continuation of our lighting efficiency upgrades.
- Two water services were installed.
