INVITATION FOR BIDS:

MEMORIAL WHARF – WATERFRONT REHABILITAION

April 12th, 2021

The Edgartown Memorial Wharf Restoration Committee is seeking bids from qualified marine construction companies for the Memorial Wharf Waterfront Rehabilitation Project. The contract includes the furnishing of all equipment, materials, labor and supervision necessary to carry out the installation of new pile supported pier and sheetpile repairs at Memorial Wharf in Edgartown, MA. The work includes but is not limited to protecting the existing pavilion, which will be preserved and relocated onto the new pier structure after its constructions; demolishing and disposing of the existing timber pier; driving new steel pipe piles under the new pier; installing new steel cap beams, steel and timber stringers, and new timber decking; excavating the parking lot area; installing internal wale system; adding a new steel sheet pile deadman; and other associated work.

The project shall commence on September 15, 2021 and all pile driving activities shall be completed by January 15, 2022. The entire project shall be completed by May 20, 2022. The Contractor shall comply with all associated permitting and licensing order of conditions included with the construction package. The project location is 50 Dock Street, Edgartown, MA, in the Edgartown Harbor.

The estimated cost of the work is \$3,500,000.

Complete plans and specifications are provided as part of the bid package.

Bids must be submitted, sealed and in writing, to Child's Engineering Corporation, 34 William Way, Bellingham, MA 02019, ATTN: Andrew Nilson, in a package plainly marked "Bid for Memorial Wharf – Waterfront Rehabilitation, REF MWC-21-5" on or before 3:00pm, Friday, April 30th, 2021. No bids submitted after that time will be accepted. Bids must include all the required materials and information. Award will be made within forty-five (45) days after the bid opening. Bidders must submit a five percent (5%) bid deposit with their bid. Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, chapter 149, sections 26 and 27, the Division of Occupational Safety has determined the Prevailing Wage Rates for this work and they are included as part of the bid package. The Town of Edgartown reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in its best interest. The Town of Edgartown fully complies with federal, state, and local laws and directives governing equal opportunity, affirmative action and non-discrimination in all Town activities and actively solicits bids from MBE/WBE businesses.
