DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS
ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

Owners/Applicants: Troy Bettencourt & Donna Lowell-Bettencourt
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At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 7 July 2021, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (5-0) to grant a special permit under section 10.1 G of the zoning bylaw to permit the construction of a replacement dwelling on a preexisting, nonconforming lot as shown on the site plan (SBH - 7 June 2021) elevations and floor plans (Rob Piper-Roche - 12 March 2021). The property is at 4 Evelyn Way (Assr. Pcl. 29A-95) in the R-20 Residential District.

FINDINGS:

1. The only nonconformity is the size of the lot, which is 10,210 sq. ft. where 21,780 sq. ft. is required for a conforming lot in R-20. The new structure will conform to all setbacks and height restrictions.
2. There were no objections to the project from any town boards or departments or from any abutters.
3. The board found the proposed construction to be site appropriate and in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the bylaw and determined that the project would not have a negative effect on the neighborhood.

No additional conditions were placed on the permit
