## DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 18 August 2021, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (5-0) to grant a special permit under section 10.1 G of the zoning bylaw to permit (1) the construction of a garage with an apartment above and (2) the construction of a covered porch and an addition to the living room of the existing main house - all as shown on the site plan (Smith & Dowling - 19 July 2021) elevations and floor plans (14 February 2021). The property is located on a preexisting, nonconforming lot at 7 Forest Circle (Assr. Pcl. 11-1.343) in the R-60 Residential District.

## FINDINGS:

- 1. The only nonconformity is the size of the lot, which is located in a neighborhood of similarly sized, preexisting nonconforming lots.
- 2. The proposed alterations and additions meet all setbacks and height restrictions of the R-60 District.
- 3. There were no objections to the project from any town boards or departments or from any abutters.
- 4. The board found the proposed alterations to be appropriate and in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the bylaw and determined that the project would not have a negative effect on the neighborhood.

No additional conditions were placed on the permit
