DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 1 September 2021, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (5-0) to grant a special permit under section 2.1 B 9 of the zoning bylaw to permit the construction of a guesthouse larger than 900 sq. ft. as shown on the site plan (SBH - 24 June 2021) and elevations (Synergy MV - 7 July 2021). The guesthouse will be located on a 10 + acre parcel at 70 North Neck Road (Assr. Pcl. 31-3.2) in the R-120 Residential District.

FINDINGS:

- 1. The proposed construction meets all setbacks and height restrictions of the R-120 District.
- 2. There were no objections to the project from any town boards or departments or from any abutters.
- 3. The board found the proposal to be appropriate and in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the bylaw and determined that the project would not have a negative effect on the neighborhood.

CONDITION:

Should the property be subdivided in the future, the 1500 sq. ft. guesthouse will become the primary dwelling on the newly created lot.
