DECISION OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS ON THE REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT

Applicant: Patrick Courtney d.b.a. the Port Hunter Property Owners: Benjamin L. Hall & Brian M Hall

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At a meeting held remotely via Zoom on Wednesday, 10 November 2021, the Edgartown Zoning Board of Appeals voted unanimously (5-0) to grant a modification to a 2012 special permit and allow an increase in seating capacity from 49 to 79 seats as shown on the seating plan submitted with the request. The property is located at 55 Main Street (Assr. Pcl 20D-210) in the B-I Business District.

FINDINGS:

- 1. The board found the proposed modification to be appropriate and in harmony with the general purpose and intent of the bylaw.
- 2. The board found that the proposed increase in seating capacity will not be detrimental to the neighborhood and will contribute to the diversity of services available in Edgartown and provide additional employment.
- 3. Permission for additional seating must also be reviewed and approved by the Wastewater Department.
