Minutes: Mark Hess moved to accept the June 14th, 2022 minutes. Christine White seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Mazar-Kelly approved a revision to the FY23 budget total as it was misprinted and short \$3,000.00. The Chairman signed and approved the revision.

Ms. Faria added that they had spoken about funding sources for the Trust as well as more consistent revenue streams however, those discussions have been brief and will take more time to put together.

Mark Hess made a motion to adjourn, Maria Ventura seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 4:50 PM.
