INVITATION FOR BIDS:

NORTH WHARF – WATERFRONT REHABILITATION

August 8, 2023

The Edgartown Wharf Restoration Committee is seeking bids from qualified marine construction companies for the North Wharf Waterfront Rehabilitation Project. The contract includes the furnishing of all equipment, materials, labor and supervision necessary to carry out the installation of new pile supported pier and sheet pile repairs at North Wharf in Edgartown, MA. The work includes but is not limited to installation of a new steel sheet pile bulkhead in front of an existing stone seawall, backfilling, partial demolition and reconstruction of a timber pier, installation of an internal wale system, installation of a concrete pile cap, installation of a timber fender system, and sitework.

The project shall commence on November 1, 2023 and all pile driving activities shall be completed by January 15, 2024. The entire project shall be completed by April 12, 2024. The Contractor shall comply with all associated permitting and licensing order of conditions included with the construction package.

The project location is 1 Morse Street, Edgartown, MA, in the Edgartown Harbor.

Complete plans and specifications are provided as part of the bid package.

Bids must include all the required materials and information. Award will be made within thirty (30) days after the bid opening. Bidders must submit a five percent (5%) bid deposit with their bid. Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, chapter 149, sections 26 and 27, the Division of Occupational Safety has determined the Prevailing Wage Rates for this work and they are included as part of the bid package. The Town of Edgartown reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in bids received whenever such rejection or waiver is in its best interest.
