

**Town of Edgartown
Selectboard
July 31, 2023
4:00 pm**

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the Fred B. Morgan, Jr. Meeting Room of Town Hall. Members present were: Arthur Smadbeck, Chairman; Michael J. Donaroma and Margaret E. Serpa. Also present was the Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00 pm Mr. Smadbeck opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was a request to excavate and block a portion of a public road from White Lynch for the Hospital project at 490 Edg/VH Road. Present for the project was Mr. Greg Keler.

Mr. Keler stated that there would be two taps on the bike path 150' apart and would like to do the work the following Wednesday the 2nd and Thursday the 3rd. They have worked out a way for the bike traffic to get around the construction.

Police Chief McNamee stated that the applicants have a plan for minimal blockage and a safe detour for bike traffic. He approved of the plan.

Highway Superintendent Alan deBettencourt stated that he approved as long as there was a plan for the bikes, which there was, and a copy of the insurance certificate was submitted.

Ms. Serpa moved to approve the work as long as the office receives proof of insurance. Mr. Donaroma seconded. Unanimous.

The Board then approved the following items:

Two one day liquor licenses for artist receptions at the Eisenhower Gallery on August 6th and 10th.

A one day liquor license for the Library for August 14th.

A new Common Victualler License for Lilikoi Café at the Triangle.

Approved and signed the Nuisance/Dangerous Dog Orders from the recent week's hearings.

A Permit for hanging a banner for the Jabberwocky 5K.

The Minutes of July 17th.

The weekly bill warrants.

At 4:07 pm Ms. Serpa moved to adjourn. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. The Board did a rollcall vote and all voted Aye. Unanimous
