Water sampling by DMF is on-going but there are no issues thus far. The Friends of Sengekontacket interns have hit the ground running and Department operations are running smoothly.

The Committee discussed whether the water temperature in the ponds is monitored. Rob said that DMF takes temperatures when they sample and he can share a link to that data.

The season will begin on Monday, June 26 and will end Friday, September 8.

MIDDLE FLATS AQUACULTURE AREAS

Rob reached out to Ms. Lipke, the former recorder for the Committee; she has records of approvals for lease areas for Sandy Fisher and Liam Cosgrove from 2020. Those applications never went to a public hearing, but the approvals are still valid and Rob will make sure the process is completed. DMF and the Selectboard need to approve the coordinates for each lease site so Rob can provide that information to the lessees. He will also seek approval for additional lease areas to be added.
