EDGARTOWN AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROPOSED WARRANT ARTICLE

1. THAT THE TOWN VOTE TO INCREASE THE ROOM OCCUPANCY EXCISE LOCAL TAX RATE FROM 4% to 6%, pursuant to G.L.C. 64G SECTION 3A.

EXPLANATION FOR #1

TOWNS IN DUKES COUNTY ARE ALLOWED TO IMPOSE A ROOM OCCUPANCY EXCISE TAX RATE TAX OF UP TO 6%. ALL TOWNS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CHILMARK AND EDGARTOWN IMPOSE A TAX OF 6%. EDGARTOWN CURRENTLY HAS A RATE OF 4%. THE TAX IS PAID BY THE RENTER AND REVENUES ARE DEPOSITED IN THE TOWN'S GENERAL FUND. IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THIS FEE INCREASE WOULD ANNUALLY ADD 1.5 TO 2 MILLION DOLLARS TO THE TOWN'S REVENUES.
