MEETING MINUTES – June 27<sup>th</sup> 2023 – 2:00 PM

The Board of Health met via Zoom. This meeting will be recorded.

Attendees: Connor Downing, Chris Edwards, Gretchen Regan, Candace Nichols, Chris Alley and Emily Godfrey.

Gretchen introduced the meeting and called the meeting to order.

Called to order at 2:05pm

Introduction of Emily Godfrey, new BOH Assistant

Connor presented the following bills for approval:

- Derosa's \$65 office supplies (paper for permits)
- Island health care billing month of May

Chris made a motion to pass the bills.

Decision: APPROVED.

Connor requested the approval of the June 13<sup>th</sup> minutes session and Chris made a motion to approve it. Agreed to table future meeting times and will strike through "through the winter" on minutes.

Decision: APPROVED.

Agent's Report:

Business as usual. All camp inspections done. Need to follow up with Boys & Girls clubs regarding food inspection. We have officially permitted 100 food establishments in town.

Candace Nicholas joined the meeting at 2:12 pm

Discussed job site with Chris Alley at 3 Adams Way, currently a 4-bedroom lot. Applied for and received variance for garage to go from 4 bedrooms to 6. Owner scrapped the idea of putting in town water and would instead lose a bedroom in the apartment above the garage. Original variance represented an overage of 1.7% of what would be allowed on town water. On a well, the overage increased to 6.4% even despite having 5 bedrooms instead of 6.

Candace voted for a new variance hearing, Chris agreed. Connor will re-send materials from the last time a decision was made on this project.

Variance hearing for 3 Adam's Way scheduled for July 25<sup>th</sup> at 2:45 PM.

ARPA funding for Edgartown:

County application covers different applicant requirements and general advanced treatment system requirements. Income requirement is 240% of average medium income. On one hand its simpler not to add more restrictions on top of the county requirements but on the other hand it might be better to be on same page with other towns. Total grant money is \$315,000 for funding these systems.
