I. CALL TO ORDER:

Kara will convey this to the engineer and have him submit the information for the next meeting.

IV. DREDGE REPORT

The Committee has been notified that the Water Quality Certificate for the Comprehensive Permit will expire in September, so they are working on getting an extension until the end of the year.

V. WHARF COMMITTEE REPORT

The Committee discussed the collision at the Harborside Dock, which currently does not have an approved commercial marine license. The Committee agreed that a limit on the size of boats that can dock there needs to be enforced. Ed will speak with James about this.
