- 1. <u>Project Description</u>- This application is for one time improvements to the public boat landing Wilson's Landing including new signage, symbolic fencing and installation of a new kayak rack. This public boat landing has gained popularity in recent years and needs to have the boat and kayak launching areas more clearly defined.
- 2. <u>Goals of CPA</u>-This application accomplishes the goals of the CPA by improving an existing recreation area.
- 3. <u>Project Impact-This project will have no negative impact on the citizens of Edgartown and we will measure success by seeing the kayak rack utilized and the launching area on the great pond, the trailer storage area and the parking area more clearly defined.</u>
- 4. <u>Project Action Plan and Timeline</u>- Once we had funding, we would proceed with the kayak racks being fabricated if they were built off site. If they are built on site, we will wait until after Labor Day to have they built as it is too busy in the summer to construct them. Symbolic fencing and signage will also be installed after Labor Day.
- 5. <u>Project Financial Information</u>- There is no capital budget for this project, annual revenue or operating expenses or annual cost to the town. These are one time improvements.
- 6. <u>Project Legal Ramifications</u>- There are no legal ramifications for this project.
- 7. Project Authorization- This property is owned by the Town of Edgartown and governed by the Edgartown Park Commissioners. The Department will need to appear before the Conversation Commission and the Planning Board for permission to install a kayak rack but we do not foresee any issues and will adhere to all advice and guidelines.
