## Update on Town Counsel review of Rules & Regulations

Town Counsel is in the process of reviewing our current Rules & Regulations to ensure they are accurate and current. We should expect to hear back from them with an update at a later time.

## 56 N. Water St. email/response

Mr. Chapman updated the Commissioner with the email communication between him and Mr. Seavey, the attorney that represents Mr. Hajjar wants the Water Department to pay for the water main installation that was required to meet the specific needs of his building. Mr. Chapman advised Mr. Seavey that the installation requirements were standard and coincide with the requirements of all other applicants that have paid for water main extensions.

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#### **Building permit approval process**

Mr. Chapman presented proposed language that outlines when the Building Department is requested to notify the Water Department about pending applications so the Water Department may be aware of potential impacts to the water system and may advise accordingly.

Bill spoke to the Chief of the Drinking Water Program at the DEP regarding discrepancies on the Sanitary Survey. We are actually up to date on all of our backflow tests and cross connection surveys. Mr. McLaughlin, DEP, asked that Mr. Chapman give them a plan for their Cross-Connection Control Program and the survey report would be amended. At this time all cross-connection surveys & backflow tests have been completed.
