Meshacket: Mark prepared a letter to go with the preliminary concept for the Meshacket project. The letter was read out loud and discussed. It was agreed that copies of the concept and letter will be distributed to the Selectmen, Planning Board, Conservation Commission and the Dukes County Regional Housing Authority. Mark also stated that Dick Barbini will go ahead and have a preliminary meeting with the Massachusetts Endangered Species Act (MESPA) regulators to discuss the moth habitat on the property. It was suggested to get prices for modular construction from various companies.

The Committee passed on the demo delay bylaw notice for 39 Fuller Street. Christina passed out a copy of the 3rd interim report for the Housing Needs Assessment.
