

PRESENT: Donna L. Goodale, Chairman of the Board; Alan Gowell, member of the Board; Jo-Ann Resendes, Principal Assessor; Cindy Sherman, Administrative Assistant, EdPierce Data Collector; and John Schaefer and Pamela Zilly

The Chairman brought the meeting to order at 2:55pm.

John Schaefer and Pamela Zilly came in to discuss why they feel their property is overvalued compared to other property similar to theirs.
