Jo-Ann gave the Board an overview of the State owned land valuations. The values are up by \$10,000,000. She explained how the values are arrived at and that the state is changing the process. She advised the Board to wait and see what the final values come out to be and see if the Town needs to appeal the value.

Jo-Ann told the Board she received a letter from Vision Appraisal, concerning an upgrade for their system and that they can expect it to cost more money. Mr. Gowell asked if he would be able to get parcel information when he is out in the field on his mobile phone. Jo-Ann explained to him how to use Axis GIS.

After motion made and seconded, the Board voted to abate \$300,700 from the value on an abatement application for Bown (29B-10).
