

PRESENT: Laurence A. Mercier, Chairman of the Board; Alan Gowell, members of the Board; Jo-Ann Resendes, Principal Assessor; and C. Bonnell, Administrative Assistant

The Chairman opened the meeting at 3:00 PM.

After motion made and seconded, the minutes of the December 18, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved.

The Board voted to remove the Chapter 59 fines assessed to Sari Lipkin (20D-217.4B) and Charles Hajjar (29D-214.2). The Board also denied the request to remove the fines for Michael Robert Barnes (21-6.37 and 21-6.38).

Jo-Ann reported to the Board that the secretary for Benjamin Hall notified her about these fines and may contact the Board in the future.

The Board voted unanimously to transfer money from various overlay accounts to overlay surplus as follows: \$25,000 from the 2009 overlay and \$10,000 from both 2010 and 2011. The \$45,000 transferred can be appropriated at the annual town meeting to fund the warrant article for revaluation money. Jo-Ann will verify the balances with the town accountant.
