I. Call to order

- c) The committee discussed the Fuller St Beach project. With 3,000 feet of pipeline it is necessary for a crew member to be monitoring the flow of sand out of the pipe and onto the beach. Provided the weather remains nice, the committee estimated about 3 weeks of dredging left.
- d) General discussion about how the sand being pumped to Fuller St is affecting the spit at the Lighthouse as well as how the tides influence the movement of sand in and out of the Harbor.
- e) A survey of the currents was recommended in order to consider how a jetty might help with the accumulation of sand around the entrance to the Harbor.
- f) The committee discussed how best to utilize the CPC mone, y if it is voted and approved at Town Meeting.
- g) Motion placed on the floor by Peter to approve the FY17 Budget Request, Dudley seconds, vote taken and passed.
- h) The committee discussed the Policies and Procedures for the Dredge Crew and how best to ensure they are implemented and utilized.
- i) The committee reviewed the invoices and authorized payment of the bills.

Peter motioned to adjourn the meeting. Les seconds the motion. No discussion, vote taken, passed unanimously.
