NEW BUSINESS

Captain Kelly said we should look at getting a price to paint the interior of the apparatus bay. Maybe we could power wash it first and see what that does. Chief will check with Randy.

Chief received a copy of an email from Klingensmith that was to Pam Dolby. He feels he is permanently disabled and is in agreement that the town should continue to proceed in that direction.

Scott asked if anyone knows about the First Responder class being offered. Wondering if its recert or for first time people. Mike said he wasn't sure but should talk to Alex.

We're doing a CPR class here in March.

Chief said that the boat engines are here. He went with Tony to the Selectmen's meeting to talk about receiving funds for the boat. It's getting painted now. Plan is to put it in water in Feb. to test things. The Coast Guard will be conducting the training for the boat and the test is conducted through and independent 3rd party.
