# Historic District Commission

## ~MINUTES~

August 5, 2014

Members Present: James Cisek, Carole Berger, Edith Blake & David Thompson.

Chairman Cisek called the meeting to order at 4:01. There was no meeting on July 15<sup>th</sup> due to lack of quorum. The following applications were continued from July 15<sup>th</sup>.

**99 Main St. (20D-64) MV Preservation Trust. (*Daniel Fisher House*)**

Meg Rothman/agent. Applicant proposes the installation of a 6 ft. white wood fence, with decorative top & gate on the west side of the Daniel Fisher House. Continued from 7.1.14. Meg came the meeting to present a new plan which will be 29' long and 10' deep. The new design is 5 feet tall boards painted white with a decorative top similar to the Jonathon Monroe house, across the street. Motion to approve as presented with the changes to design as presented, Edith Blake. 2<sup>nd</sup> Carole Berger. Approved.

**99 A Main St. (20D-64) MV Preservation Trust. (*Vincent House*)**

Meg Rothman/agent. Applicant proposes the installation of a 3ft. natural cedar fence (to weather), to surround new colonial kitchen garden. Work completed. Meg presented the plan for the garden fence and showed pictures. All members like the design. Meg noted that the Kitchen Garden will be a feature of Tours for the Vincent house. Motion to approve as presented, Carole Berger. 2<sup>nd</sup> David Thompson. Approved.

**68 Winter St. (20D-110.1-110.6) 68 Winter St. Trust/Thomas McGrath.**

(*Edgartown Lodge*) - Change to an approved plan. Applicant proposes to replace old stockade fence with new 6 foot cedar fence, painted white. Continued from 7.1.14 Thomas McGrath appeared to discuss the fence. There was discussion regarding the fencing the commission concerned that there are too many fence types at this corner. Mr. McGrath suggested extending the current picket fence to the edge of the property with no gate. This idea was well received by the members of the commission.

Motion to approve of the fence as a continuation of the current white picket fence, David Thompson. 2<sup>nd</sup> Carole Berger. Approved.

Expansion letter – It was proposed to continue work on the expansion letter until October 2014. Unanimously Approved to continue the project.
