

Selectmen's Meeting
February 10, 2020
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Margaret E. Serpa, Chairman and Arthur Smadbeck. Also present was Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00 pm Ms. Serpa opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was the Annual Pink and Green Festival that the Board of Trade hosts on Mother's Day Weekend. Present was Julia Tarka.

Ms. Tarka requested the following items:

- Hang a banner across Main Street from May 4th to May 10th. This is the same banner as previous years.
- Hang pink and green burgees on the light posts from the top of Main Street (Daniel Fisher House to the top of North Water Street) from April 27th to May 11th.
- Host a dog show and celebration of animals in the Mini Park on Saturday May 9th at 1 pm. Event benefits the MV Animal Shelter.
- Horse & Carriage Rides on Saturday, May 9th from noon - 2 pm for families. The ride will depart from the loading zone spot in front of Rosebud Kids, and loop around downtown. Any horse droppings will be collected and disposed of immediately.
- Annual 5K Race.

Mr. Smadbeck moved to approve the requests. Ms. Serpa seconded. Unanimous.

Ms. Serpa then moved on to the next item which was the Amity Island 5k. The request was to hold the race on August 2nd and hang a banner over Main St. 7/26-8/1.

The Board then set a Liquor License Public Hearing for Chesca's restaurant for a change of ownership on February 24, 2020 at 4pm.

A Travel Voucher and Commitments for the Harbormaster.

To allow the Newes Pub to host the Annual Wee Parade on St. Patrick's Day.

To appoint Doug Jones to the MVC Bike and Pedestrian Committee.
