

Selectmen's Meeting
March 4, 2019
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Michael J. Donaroma, Chairman; Margaret E. Serpa and Arthur Smadbeck. Also present was Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00pm Mr. Donaroma opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was Peter Wells, Chappy Ferry owner.

Mr. Wells stated that he is changing his banks for his business loan and needs the Board to sign off on it.

Ms. Serpa stated that they will have to have Town Counsel review it. She suggested continuing until next week. The Board agreed.

To set a shellfish hearing for Nick Viera for March 18, 2019 at 4pm.

To send a letter to Representative Fernandez and Senator Cyr in opposition to the formation of the Housing Bank and the funding from the Short Term Rental Tax.
