

Selectmen's Meeting
June 3, 2019
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Margaret E. Serpa, Chairman, Arthur Smadbeck and Michael J. Donaroma. Also present was Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00pm Ms. Serpa opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was the promotion of Detective Michael Snowden. Present was Police Chief Bruce McNamee, what seemed like the whole police department and Detective Snowden's wife, family and friends.

Chief McNamee started by giving a short history of Mr. Snowden's education and police history. He then recommended Mr. Snowden be promoted to the rank of Sergeant.
