

Selectmen's Meeting
June 10, 2019
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Margaret E. Serpa, Chairman, Arthur Smadbeck and Michael J. Donaroma. Also present was Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00pm Ms. Serpa opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was a shade tree hearing to remove and replace a tree at 80 S. Summer Street. Present was Tree Warden and Highway Superintendent Alan deBettencourt.

Ms. Serpa stated that she understood the request by looking at the tree. The others agreed.

Mr. deBettencourt stated that he supported the removal and the replacement with a 3"-4" caliper tree of the species to be determined and approved by himself.

Mr. Donaroma moved to approve the removal and replacement of the tree with a 3-4" caliper tree of a species approved by the Tree Warden by October 31, 2019. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. Unanimous.

The Board then set a public hearing for June 24th at 4:00 pm for a street license for All Star Tours.

The Board then approved the following items:

New application forms for Roadraces/Walks and Banners.

Entertainment and One Day Liquor Licenses for Meals in the Meadow at the Farm Institute.

A Travel Voucher for the Harbormaster's Office.

To appoint James Cisek as the Historic District Commission Alternate Member.

Mr. Hagerty then updated everyone on the monument at the corner of Pease Point Way and Main Street. It seems that when the town tried to get it painted that alerted Eversource who feels it is too close to the wires. This is the reason it has not been painted and there is no longer a flag flying there. The Town is trying to work with Eversource toward a solution.

At 4:12 PM Mr. Smadbeck moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Donaroma seconded. Unanimous
