

Selectmen's Meeting
September 3, 2019
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Margaret E. Serpa, Chairman; Arthur Smadbeck and Michael J. Donaroma. Also present was Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00pm Ms. Serpa opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was an alteration to the Chappy Ferry Lease. Present were Owners Peter Wells and Sally Snipes as well as Attorney Doug Seiderholm and several members of the public from Chappaquiddick.

Mr. Seiderholm explained that the change is adding the MV Savings Bank to the lease as financial backing. He went over the details and months of preparation with Town Counsel and the bank.
