

Selectmen's Meeting
November 13, 2018
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Margaret E. Serpa and Arthur Smadbeck. Also present was Town Administrator James Hagerty.

At 4:00pm Ms. Serpa opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was a permit to block a portion of a public way for 122 N. Water Street. Present was Mike Carroll, construction supervisor.

Mr. Carroll explained that the porches on the front of the house need extensive repair and they abut the sidewalk. He would like permission to block the sidewalk and the parking space adjacent for safety.

Mr. Smadbeck moved to approve the request. Ms. Serpa seconded. Unanimous.

The Board then also approved a permit to block a portion of the public way for the Harborside to place a dumpster in the loading zone outside their property on 3 S. Water Street for one day for removal of carpets.

The Board then approved the following items:

A Travel Voucher for the Police Department.

A Permit to Excavate for Farrisey on Road to the Plains.

For the Town Hall to close for the whole day on Monday December 24th.

To appoint Lisa Sherman to the MV Cultural Council.

To appoint Les Baynes and Juliet Mulinare to the Christmas Committee.

Ms. Serpa then recognized Erin Ready from the Board of Trade (BOT).

Ms. Ready wanted to give an update on Christmas in Edgartown. After her update she asked the Board to approve a banner and the parade. She also asked them to think about letting the BOT use the parking lot at the Town Wharf for the lighthouse lighting just for this year because the Harborview is closed.

The Board approved the banner and parade and took the parking lot use under consideration.

At 4:15 PM Ms. Serpa moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. Unanimous
