

Selectmen's Meeting
May 22, 2017
4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Arthur Smadbeck, Chairman; Michael Donaroma, and Margaret Serpa. Also present was Town Administrator Pamela Dolby.

At 4:00pm Mr. Smadbeck opened the meeting and the discussion concerning Collins Beach. Present were Steve Ewing and Harbormaster Charlie Blair.

Mr. Ewing gave a brief history of Collins Beach as a working beach for those that work with boats and the sea.

Mr. Blair proposed two signs stating "Permit Parking Only" for those with Commercial Marine Licenses for Marine Repair. It's a difficult subject. Chief Rossi has agreed that there needs to be clearer signage of who can and can't park there and the time limits if any. It's hard to enforce as is.

Mr. Donaroma stated that it was complicated. Marine use is a protected use for the beach. He doesn't like the permitting idea. Need a way to eliminate the non-marine parkers.

Ms. Serpa stated that the people with moorings also use that beach for access.

Mr. Blair and Mr. Ewing stated that they are looking for direction from the Board. They see the situation everyday down there and it's not good. Mr. Blair will enforce whatever they want.

The Board took it all under advisement and will try and come up with a plan.

The Board then appointed the following police officers as Assistant Harbormasters: Chief Rossi; Sgts. Edwards, Smith, DeRoche, and Gazaille; Detective Snowden; and Officers Bishop, Trudel, Ruley and Sylvia.

Mr. Blair and School Principal John Stevens then discussed the Annual March to the Sea. The town wharf has been under renovations. They would meet with the contractor tomorrow to try to make arrangements and let the Board know the outcome.
