Selectmen's Meeting May 2, 2016 4:00 pm

A meeting of the Board was held on the above date in the meeting room of Town Hall. Members present were: Margaret E. Serpa, Chairman; Arthur Smadbeck and Michael J. Donaroma. Also present was Town Administrator Pamela Dolby.

At 4:00pm Ms. Serpa opened the meeting and the first item on the agenda which was an alteration of premises to a liquor license at Behind the Bookstore. Mr. Donaroma abstained. Representing the applicant was attorney Sean Murphy.

Mr. Murphy explained that the plan was to demolish a small addition in the back of the bookstore and replace it with patio space and more tables for the restaurant. ZBA has approved.

At 4:02pm Ms. Serpa closed the hearing. Mr. Smadbeck moved to approve the alteration. Ms. Serpa seconded. Unanimous. Mr. Donaroma returned to the meeting.

The Board then approved the following items:

A letter of retirement from James Harrison from the Katama Airfield Commission.

A Yard Sale for William LeRoyer at 256 Edg/VH Rd. on May 15th.

The Board set a public hearing for a new liquor license for MV Taco Shack for May 16th at 4:00pm.

At 4:05pm Ms. Serpa opened the hearing for an alteration of premises for Isola to erect a tent for special occasions over the courtyard facing Church Street. Present was Peter Sullo, owner.

Mr. Sullo stated that the tent would be for 4 or 5 private parties a year. The patrons would enter in and out of the restaurant and there would be no access from the street. He has 2 scheduled for this year so far.

Ms. Serpa closed the hearing at 4:07pm. There being no further comment Mr. Donaroma moved to approve. Mr. Smadbeck seconded. Unanimous.

At 4:10 PM Mr. Donaroma moved to go into Executive Session to discuss pending litigation and not to return into public session. Ms. Serpa seconded. A roll call vote was held where all voted aye. Unanimous.
